PROCLAMATION

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, formed in 2014, the Indy Metropolitan Military Honor Guard (IMMHG) has performed on average an estimated 400 Military Funeral Honors for fallen comrades in and around Marion County; and

WHEREAS, with a roster of an average of 23 active members, the IMMHG renders military honors regardless of race, color, religion, or affiliation with a veteran's organization. They rely on donations alone from families and funeral home partners; and

WHEREAS, the team puts in an estimated 6,000 hours of work and 57,000 miles of travel each year to complete these Funeral Honors as well as Color Guard performances; and

WHEREAS, today, we honor these volunteer veterans for their selfless work on behalf of Marion County veterans and their families, and we thank them for their continued service to our community;
